In the enclosed letter, inmate Peltier admits to receiving the bank note in the mail. It is obvious that inmate Peltier was in possession of money that was not authorized.



11. DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT (Date 6-27-2011 Time 9:45AM. Staff become aware of incident)
 On the above date and time while performing a search of cell A 105 I observed two wires protruding approximately 2 inches from the wall of the cell. One of the wires was orange in color, the other was orange and white in color. The wires were located on the wall above the corner post of the upper bunk. I attempted to pull the wires out of the wall. Due to my correctional experience in the past I have witnessed inmates conceal contraband in the wall of a cell and attach a wire, or string to the contraband. This is so the item may be retrieved at a later time. As I attempted to pull the wire out of the wall my grip failed, my fingers slipped on the wire and contacted the bare ends of the wire. At that time I received an electrical shock through my right hand and forearm up to my right elbow. Further visual inspection revealed that the two wires were leading to the light of the cell. Inmate Peltier is 89637-132 is the only inmate assigned to cell A 105.
