

HICKS admitted attending AIM National Convention, White Oak Oklahoma, July, 1973.

HICKS advised that as he recalls, on 6/22/75 he was riding a bus from Phoenix, Arizona, to Sonora, Texas, where he visited his cousin, KAREN BOWMAN, 610 Tayloe. Prior, to leaving Phoenix for Sonora, he lived at various locations in Phoenix. He may be confused as to the exact date that he traveled between Phoenix and Sonora, but after he arrived at Sonora, he traveled with his cousin KAREN and her husband back to Oklahoma, Arkansas, and back to Phoenix.

Upon returning to Phoenix, he spent most of his time during the months of July and August, 1975 with the daughter of Mrs. (FNU) MILES, 3601 LaSalle. JOANNE MILES presently is attending college in Minnesota and resides at 2417 Elliot Street. It is his intention as soon as he has funds to join Miss MILES in Minnesota. He is sure that the BOWMANs can verify his whereabouts.in mid June, 1975.



ROBERT CHAFFEE, Assistant Production Manager, Smith & Wesson, Incorporated, 2100 Roosevelt Avenue, Springfield, Massachusetts, was interviewed at his place of business. After examining the .357 Magnum claiber Smith & Wesson, Model 19 revolver bearing the number 310439 on the cylinder and extractor, Chaffee provided the following information:

The presence of the number 310439 on the extractor counterbore of the cylinder indicates that the cylinder was re-worked or repaired. This repair could have occurred during the manufacturing of the revolver or the revolver may have been returned to the factory for repair after it was sold. This number would have been stamped, on the cylinder because in effecting the repairs it was necessary to remove the cylinder. Having the number on the cylinder insures it will be replaced in the same frame from which it was removed.

The number 310439 lacks only the frame symbol letter from being a complete serial number. This letter was probably omitted in stamping the serial number on the cylinder and on the underside of the extractor because of the limited space available. However, the number 310439, although missing the frame symbol, describes only one .357 Magnum caliber -Model 19 revolver ever produced by Smith & Wesson. That revolver has the Serial Number 3K10439.



Mr. Bachman, provided a copy of Smith & Wesson invoice number 16489 which lists the .357 Magnum caliber. Model 19 revolver, Serial Number 3K10439 as having been shipped to Simon Atlas Sons, Incorporated on June 21, 1972.

Mr. Bachman advised that James A. Isom, Foreman of the Shipping Department, is the custodian of shipping records for Smith & Wesson.



Enclosed for each receiving office are one copy each of three self-explanatory FD-302s of SA Roger A. Asbury (FBI Laboratory) and SA Jack W. Sullivan (Boston) dated 9/16/75 at Springfield, Massachusetts, one Smith & Wesson (S & W) invoice #D164 to Simon Atlas Sons, Incorporated, dated 6/21/72, and one shipping order #16489 to Simon Atlas Sons, Incorporated, 11331 Maryland Avenue, Beltsville, Maryland 20705, dated 6/21/72.

For information of receiving offices, referenced Boston teletype advises that on 9/12/75 James A. Isom, Shipping Department, S & W, Incorporated, Springfield, Massachusetts, advised S & W Model 19 .357 caliber Magnum revolver, serial #3K10439, was shipped on 6/21/72 under invoice #16489 to Simon Atlas Sons, Incorporated, Beltsville, Maryland. This revolver was the personal property of SA Ronald A. Williams, which he was authorized by FBIHQ to carry on official business on 8/21/72. This weapon was stolen from SA Williams at the time of his death on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation 6/26/75 and was recovered as a result of a

raid conducted on the Rosebud Indian Reservation in a CIR - Assault case on 9/5/75. Referenced teletype also sets out information regarding the serial number of this gun which is furnished in more detail in the enclosed FD-302S.

The FBI Laboratory determined the serial numbers on the frame and crane were ground off and punched to prevent number restoration. Further examination by the FBI Laboratory located the digital portions of the serial number stamped on the inside face of the extractor and the face of the extractor recess on the cylinder. As noted in the FD-302s of Mr. Robert Chaffee, Assistant Production Manager, S & W, Incorporated, the digital number 310439, although missing the frame symbol (K), describes only one .357 Magnum caliber Model 19 revolver ever produced by S & W. That revolver has the serial number 3K10439.

The personnel file of SA Williams at FBIHQ indicates he had the magnum approved while assigned to his first office (Seattle) in August, 1972. It would appear SA Williams purchased the above magnum while attending new Agents training at Simon Atlas Sons, Incorporated, in Washington, D. C. (now Herman's Atlas). Information has been received that the distributor for Herman's Atlas is B. F. Grace Company at Beltsville, Maryland. Baltimore institute investigation at B. F. Grace Company concerning the shipment of SA Williams' revolver from S & W, Springfield, Massachusetts, to Simon Atlas Sons, Incorporated. It is to be noted the weapon was shipped 6/21/72 and SA Williams terminated his new Agents training on 8/2/72. Furnish results by FD-302 to SACs, Rapid City, Boston, Minneapolis, and WFO and FBIHQ.

WFO, upon receipt,of FD-302s from Baltimore, institute investigation at Herman's Atlas, Washington, D. C. WFO furnish results of investigation by FD-302s to SACs, Rapid City, Boston, and Baltimore and FBIHQ.

A complete trace of this weapon must be accomplished as it will be needed in court as evidence to trace this weapon and ownership by SA Williams. Of particular interest will be a copy of the documents consummating the sale to SA Williams which contain his signature. Should Herman's Atlas be agreeable, these documents should be obtained and marked

as evidence and a Xerox copy of them, along with a receipt, should be furnished to Herman's Atlas. In the event Herman's Atlas is not agreeable to this procedure, notify SAC, Rapid City, so that appropriate subpoena can be issued by the U. S. Attorney in the District of South Dakota.

This important phase of the RESMURS investigation is to receive preferred investigative and supervisory attention.

For information of receiving offices, a search of Tent City, Oglala, South Dakota, following the shooting; revealed in part a one pound can of smokeless powder. Powder described as Dupont IMR-3031. Code P735Y13B. Dupont, Wilmington, Delaware, advised 36 cases of this powder were shipped to Dole Explosives, Rosemount, Minnesota; on 9/5/73.

HOMER ORRELL, Broadway Sportsland Shooters Supply, 755 Broadway, Merrillville, Indiana, advised on 9/4/75, that he deals almost exclusively with reloading equipment for shotgun shooters. Very little of his business is done with supplies for rifle shooters and IMR-3031 is used exclusively for rifles; He indicated he does occasionally order IRM-3031 to be redistributed to gun shops dealing with rifle reloading. He advised he reviewed his records and they did not indicate where he had resold this powder but that the following people are the only purchasers of rifle powder he recalls:



Mr. ORRELL stated he has had no thefts or missing powder to his knowledge, and that in view of the fact that they ware redistributed sin 1-lb. cans, he has no record of these purchases.

JACK BATZ, Jack's Gun Shop, Route 20, Burns Harbor, Indiana, advised that the North West Indiana area is 99% shotgun shooters, and he has little, if any, need for rifle powder. He advised that he has two people who occasionally reload rifle ammunition and that neither of them nor himself has had any theft of IMR-3031. He also advised that he has not had any of this powder for at least a year due to its lack of use in this area.
